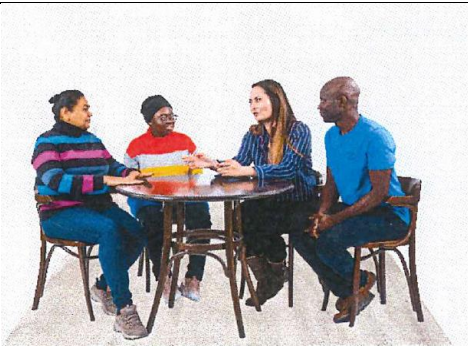


What is a learning disability?

- People usually have a learning disability from birth or, sometimes from early childhood.
- People with learning disabilities are not all the same. They have different needs and lives.

What is the RBKC Learning disability Team?

- The RBKC Learning Disability Team is part of the wider Adult social Care Department
- The Team offers Care Act Needs Assessments to people with a learning disability.
- RBKC Learning Disability Team support people with their assessed need and offers a range of services people can choose from to meet their needs.



- The Team supports young people with a learning disability to prepare for adulthood and with their transitions from children's services into adult services.
- The Team support Adults when they need it.

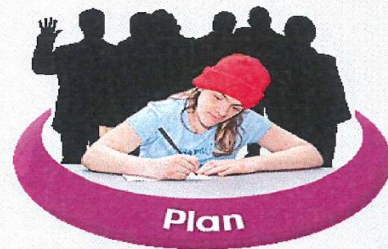

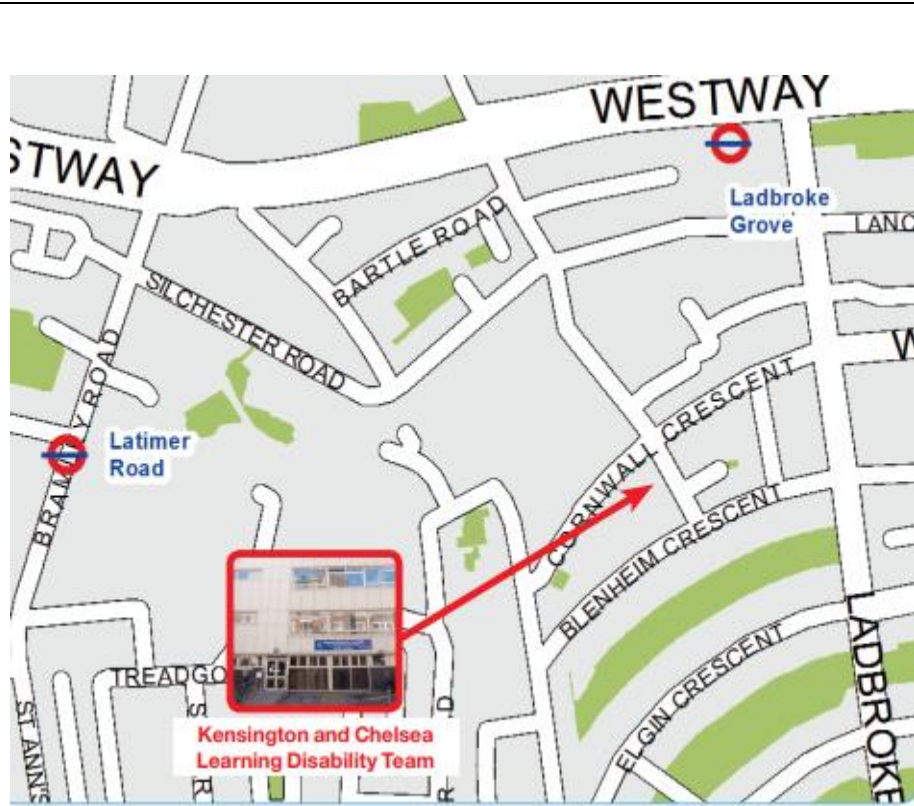
