According to the London Fire Brigade's (LFB) figures there is, on average, one fire in London every day involving white goods. Around 90 per cent of the fires caused by these are not down to human factors but by faults beyond the control of the householder.

The LFB are still attending fires where there are no working smoke alarms. Everyone should have at least one smoke alarm on every level of their home and the safest option is to have them linked together.

Fires and fire deaths continue on a downward trend, but the LFB want to ensure they reach those most at risk from fire and the most in-need residents across the borough.

The local fire brigade wants to identify people who:

-  live alone
-  have a physical, mental health or learning disability
-  live in social housing
-  are over 60
-  are single parents with a child under 15
-  smoke.

Their homes can be assessed and smoke alarms installed where needed, with officers able to give important fire safety advice - **all free of charge.**
