## What is ZOOM?

A free online video communication tool.



- A helpful resource, keeping people connected that enables you to access community services during the coronavirus lockdown, such as:
  - Fitness classes
  - Arts and crafts
  - Online meetings

## **STEP 1:** Click your invite <u>link</u>. You may receive this by text (for example, on WhatsApp) or email.

## STEP 2: Install Zoom.

Already have Zoom installed? Go to STEP 3.

#### Don't have Zoom on your computer?

When you click on your first invite link, it will initiate download (you only need to do this once!).

#### **STEP 3:** Join the meeting.

**Option A** -> Click the link (see STEP 1) to join meeting instantly. Create your username and click 'Join Meeting'.

#### **Option B** -> Open the Zoom app.

## How to Zoom? A Guide for Beginners

#### The Sound!

When you join the online session, you might need to turn on your audio so that everyone can hear you. For example, to join a coffee morning.

To do this: when you join the meeting, it will say '**Join with Audio**'. Click YES.

If you would like to turn OFF your microphone during the call:

• Click 'Mute' at the bottom left-hand corner of

the screen.



- Now you will see a **red line** through the 'mute' button and it will say 'unmute'.
- To turn the microphone back ON: Click the 'unmute' button at the <u>bottom left-hand corner</u> <u>of the screen</u>.

## Your Screen!

The person who is speaking will be the one on the big screen. Everyone else joining the session will be in the smaller screens.

If you would like to see everyone on the screen as the same size:

• Click the '**Gallery View**' button at the <u>top right-hand corner of your screen</u>.

Gallery View

The greater the number of people joining the session, the smaller they will look on the screen.

To go back to the original screen at the beginning (one big screen of the person speaking):

• Click the '**Speaker View**' button at the <u>top</u> <u>right-hand corner of your screen</u>.



### The Video!

To turn OFF your camera (so that no one can see you):

• Click 'Stop Video' at the bottom left-hand corner

<u>of the screen</u>.



- The same button will now say 'Start Video' and have a **red line** through the image of the video camera.
- To turn your video camera back on, click the '**Start Video**' button at the <u>bottom left-hand</u>

corner of the screen.



## How to leave the meeting!

You can leave the session at any time. To leave:

• Click 'Leave Meeting' at the <u>bottom right-hand</u> <u>corner of the screen</u>.
